

Birthday Cupcake Box

assembly instructions



details:


This 3D Birthday Cupcake Box paper template project is perfect to hold a small gift or treats. The Cupcake Box, Stand, Rosette and Flower are sold separately in the Silhouette Store. This instruction set includes assembly for all parts. Assembling time is approximately an hour or so depending on skill level.

supplies:

To complete this fun and festive birthday cupcake shaped box for gift giving and display you will need the following supplies:

- 3D Birthday Cupcake Box template
- 3D Birthday Cupcake Stand template
- 3D Birthday Rolled Rosette template
- 3D Birthday Rolled Flower template
- letter size paper cardstock
- quick dry tacky glue or other adhesives

Birthday Cupcake Box Assembly Instructions




Step 1: Cut all template pieces from desired cardstock.



Step 2: Fold and glue tab of part 1.



Step 3: Adhere to part 2 of the cupcake box, both parts join together to form one piece.



Step 4: Glue bottom tabs of the box and adhere to the larger flap by folding it down on top of the smaller tabs.

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Step 5: Glue bottom tabs of the box and adhere to the larger flap by folding it down on top of the smaller tabs.



Step 6: Fold in every other flap on top, curling each flap as you go.



Step 7: To close the top of the cupcake box, insert one slot into another slot.




Step 8: Then slide in the third slot in between the other two flaps.


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Step 9: When the cupcake box is closed, the top should look like this.



Step 10: Cut both parts of the cupcake box liner. Crease along perforated fold lines.



Step 11: Glue side tab.




Step 11: Adhere to the side of the other part of the liner.


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
Step 12: Glue the side tab and adhere to the other side of the liner.



Step 13: Glue bottom tabs of the liner and adhere to the larger flap by folding it down on top of the smaller tabs.



Step 14: Allow glue to dry.



Step 15: Completed liner can be used separately, or place the cupcake box inside the liner.

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Stand step 1: To glue together the stand, you will want to use paste or another type of non-wrinkling adhesive. I like to use YES paste applied with a paintbrush.



Step 2: Cut out 4 stand pieces. Crease all perforated fold lines. Glue the right bottom section of one of the stand pieces.



Step 3: Place another stand piece on top of the glued piece, lining up edges and folded center. Repeat with other two sections. Allow both sections to dry flat.



Step 4: Add glue to both sides of one section.

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
Step 5: Place one part of the other assembled section on top of the glue(on the right hand side), align the edges and center perforated fold.



Step 6: Fold the right hand side into the glued area on the left. Adhere to the other assembled section, aligning edges to create 4 separate legs. Allow glue to dry.




Step 7: Open all 4 sections of the stand to form an X shape. Fold down alternating sections of the rounded portion on top.



Step 8: Glue each of those sections and fold down the other flaps in the opposite direction onto the glued flap.


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Step 9: Continue with all four sections to form a circle.



Step 10: Flip upside down to dry flat. Use something heavy (like glue bottles) in each section to help it dry flat.



Step 11: Add glue to the top circle piece.



Step 12: Adhere to scalloped edge top piece. Allow to dry flat.

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Step 13: Glue the top of the base.



Step 14: Invert and place onto the center of the scallop edge top piece. Allow to dry flat. Weight the center sections if necessary.



Step 15: Fold down scallops to complete. Place the cupcake box on top, or the stand can be used for a cupcake or as doll's furniture!



Rosette Step 1: Cut rosette from desired paper. Begin by rolling the outside edge in to create a small spiral center.

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Step 2: Continue to tightly roll the center along the curve of the rosette while holding the center.



Step 3: Keep rolling!



Step 4: Wrap glued edge around the outside of the rosette. Hold until the glue has dried.



Step 5: Wrap glued edge around the outside of the rosette. Hold until the glue has dried.

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Step 6: Add glue to the center of the rosette. Set upside down to dry.



Step 7: Continue to create as many rosettes as desired. The sample cupcake box uses 18 rosettes, 3 on each flap edge.



Step 8: Once the rosette has dried, add a glue dot or tacky adhesive to the center and attach to the flap of the cupcake box where desired.



Rolled Flower Step 1: Cut flower from desired paper. Create the center of the flower by rolling the outside edge in a small spiral.


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Step 2: Add a sticky glue dot or adhesive between the scallop along the edge.



Step 3: Adhere to the center, leaving space between each roll.



Step 4: Bend down the edge of the scallop to create a petal shape.



Step 5: Continue to add adhesive between the scallops, adhere to the center, and then bend the petals as you continue roll along the edge of the spiral.

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Step 6: Once you reach the center, add adhesive to the center of the spiral.



Step 7: Adhere the rolled flower onto the center.



Step 8: To attach the rolled flower to the center of the cupcake box, add glue or adhesive to the center of one of the flaps.



Step 9: Place flower onto the flap of the cupcake box. Add the tag by sliding it underneath the flaps to complete the cupcake box set.
